The hospital will contact you the **DAY BEFORE** your procedure (or on Friday for Monday procedures), with the time of the procedure. You must report to **AMBULATORY SURGERY** at **BOTSFORD HOSPITAL** the morning of your procedure. This is located in the North Professional Building Suite 104. If for some reason you do not hear from the hospital before **2:30pm the day before** your procedure, please **call (248) 471-8420**, and they will be happy to assist you.

You must have a driver with you for the entire time of the procedure (approx. 3 hours).

EGD PREP

NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT the night before your procedure.

Medications:

Patients currently taking cardiac medications or blood pressure medications may take their medications on the morning of the procedure with a very small amount of water.

Patients taking insulin should not take their insulin on the morning of the procedure, but are to bring their insulin with them to the hospital.

Patients taking aspirin, or any medications containing aspirin, medications that cause thinning of the blood, such as: Excedrin, Bufferin, Motrin, and baby aspirin, should quit taking it five (5) days prior to the procedure.

Any prescription medications stop as follows:

Ticlid 7 days prior
Coumadin ... 5 days prior

Plavix7 days prior
Iron 5 days prior
